STEP - BY - STEP:

STEP 1: This piece was painted on inexpensive cardboard, which is very absorbent. To cut the absorbency, "prime" the board with a thin layer of Matte Medium. Matte Medium seals the surface and provides a nice tooth for subsequent layers to be applied. Use the soft flat brush to apply a thin layer. Let dry.

STEP 2: Using the soft flat brush, apply High Flow Iridescent Silver over the entire background. Let dry.

STEP 3: Use the palette knife to spread Glass Bead Gel over the silver background. Try to spread it to the thickness of a single glass bead. No, it won't be perfect. Some places will be thicker than others and there may be spots that have no coverage. That is okay. Let dry.

STEP 4: Using a clean brush, dampen the dry Glass Bead Gel surface with some clean water. Working in a watermedia fashion with loose watery washes, use the High Flow and Fluid colors to create a pear shape, leaves, stem, table and a bit of a background. Add some detail.
